- Worked in finance in the US and Europe and has traveled extensively throughout the world living overseas in London, Frankfurt, Hong Kong, and Berlin.
- Policy initiatives focus on infant and maternal health, climate change education, and fostering women-owned businesses.

- Science
- Social Studies
- Visual and Performing Arts
- World Languages



The Standards!

- New Jersey Board of Education adopted the new climate change education guidelines on June 3, 2020.
- The standards focus on K-12 and include all content areas.
- New Jersey is transitioning to a green economy with the goal of reaching 100 percent clean energy by 2050.
- We need climate literate scientists and climate literate civic leaders, policy makers, urban planners, journalists, artists, activists, teachers and more.
